RESEARCH:

CDRF has proved that diabetes is increasing in a frightening share across the districts of coastal region. Immediately after devastated Super Cyclone in the state, CDRF had published the estimation which comes for 15 lakhs diabetics living under stress and strain. A press not was released by the then Health Minister, Orissa on the basis of data of CDRF and the number of diabetics would be approximately 20 lakhs.

ACTIVITIES DURING 2009-2010

FREE DIABETES DETECTION AND TREATMENT CAMPS:

Deliberate endeavor for conduct of health camps in different places of the state is the routine work of the Organization. Health services are being provided to the deprived sector by the organization to help people for early detection of disease in the course of on the spot blood sugar examination. Counseling on prevention of Diabetes is also continuing in the state by the active supervision of the organization. In order to serve people on health issues related to

Diabetes, regular Treatment camps are being undertaken in various districts of our state(Orissa) by the effort of CUTTACK DIABETES RESEARCH FOUNDATION. This year a series of health Camps have been organized in various districts of Orissa in which people of the concerned places as well as from the adjacent Block areas were benefited. Spectacular gathering from the targeted communities have been witnessed by the service providers and Doctors. Free medicines were administered. Printed materials and the recent publications were distributed in the said camp. Apart from that the organization has been associated with the Government and Non-Government initiatives in order to work in the rural and remote areas of the district on different health related issues and to curb the predicaments and fright of diabetes of rural inhabitants. The organization is attempting to engage more volunteers for organization of health camps in rural and remote villages where health services are not properly reached.

AWARENESS DRIVE AND FREE DIABETES CAMP:

The organization has taken steps for mass awareness among the general public and people at high risk of diabetes and the focus has been laid on raising awareness on diabetes and disseminating tools for the prevention of diabetes. For people living with diabetes, the emphasis has been made disseminating tools to improve knowledge of diabetes in order understand the condition better prevent complications. Cuttack Diabetes Research **Foundation** has sincerely strived on advocacy aimed at communicating the cost-effective implications of diabetes prevention strategies and promoting diabetes education as a core component of diabetes management and treatment. The key messages of the campaign, developed for different target groups, are: Know the signs and symptoms of diabetes. Early

diagnosis saves lives. Diabetes prevention and treatment is simple and cost-effective. Your child could be affected. Know the warning signs. See your doctor to measure the risk. Enjoy an active life and prevent complications.

Programme Highlights:

Cuttack Diabetes Research Foundation and it's sister organization viz. Kanungo Institute of Diabetes Specialties (KIDS) have conducted various health care activities during this year which are

Free Diabetes Detection Camp:

elaborated below:

During the year 2009-10, the Foundation has rushed to various vulnerable places for organization of free diabetes detection camps for welfare of common people. People are sensitized on different types of diabetes likewise in type 1, the pancreas stop producing insulin due to autoimmune response or possibly viral attack on pancreas. In absence of insulin, body cells don't get the required glucose for producing ATP (Adenosin Triphosphate) units which results into primary symptom in the form of nausea and vomiting. In later stage, which leads to ketoacidosis, the body starts breaking down the muscle tissue and fat for producing energy hence, causing fast weight loss. Dehydration is also usually observed due to electrolyte

disturbance. In advanced stages, coma and death is witnessed. Similarly the major other symptoms like fatigue, feeling of thirsty, Irritability, infection and poor wound healing, large water excretion, increased hunger etc. concerning to type-2 diabetes are vividly discussed in the free health camps.

Programme on 06.09.2009 at Khurda Rotary Club:

One free diabetes detection camp has been undertaken by the staff members of CDRF and KIDS at Khurda Rotary Club on 06.09.2009. In the said camp 120 patients got free treatment privileges and Doctor's advice on diet and precautions, exercise, pills and insulin etc. The patients could also be able to know the root of complicacies of diabetes and methods of future treatment as per advice of the Doctors. People checked up their blood sugar level and acquired knowledge on the disease from the Doctors in the said camp.



Programme on 03.12.2009:

CDRF and KIDS have conducted a mega health camp on diabetes detection and free treatment at Baramunda, Bhubaneswar on 03.12.2009. People could be able to check up their blood sugar level and consulted with the diabetologist. In the said camp 124 patients were attended and undergone treatments. Dr. Alok Kanungo, Dr. Apurba Jena, Dr. Hariballav Mohapatra and others rendered their free treatment services to the people.



Programme on 19.02.2009:

One awareness program on Diabetes detection initiative was conducted on 19.02.2009 at Balakati, Bhubaneswar. Total 61 patients were attended and they have undergone treatment by the Doctors. The major activities of the camp were check up of Blood sugar level and mass sensitization on the common symptoms of diabetes among the general public.

Programme On 06.03.2010:

One mega health camp on detection and awareness program has been conducted in Officer's Club, Paradeep on 06.03.2010 in which 129 patients attended for consultation and treatment. The patients were made aware of the facts like diet

exhibition. They were covered under free check up of blood sugar level for early detection of diabetes. The associated Doctors and local level distinguished dignitaries graced the program.



Programme on 09.03.2010:

One mega health camp has been organized at NALCO Community Centre 09.03.2010. More than 60 patients attended in the camp for free blood sugar level check up and consultation with Doctors, specialists and case studies were presented before them. By the effort, the early detection of the disease could be done for care and control of the bad repercussions of the Diabetes. Diet control counseling was made among the participants and general public.

Programme on 21.03.2010:

With the active support and endeavour of CUTTACK DIABETES RESEARCH FOUNDATION, one mega health camp on detection and treatment of diabetes has been conducted at Gita Bhawan, Khurda on 21st March'2010. The reputed doctors and dignitaries of CDRF & KIDS adorned

the chair for extending care and moral support to the diabetes patients. Free health check up pertaining to blood sugar level testing and diet information was made. Total 170 patients attended the camp and undergone treatment. The focus of the program was to provide affordable treatment to the people and render humanitarian services to the diabetes patients.

Program on 28.03.2010:

During this financial year, one detection and treatment mega health camp was organized at Brajendra High School, Nayagarh District with the endeavor of CDRF and KIDS. 117 patients had undergone free treatment and counseling on diet specifications. Dr. Alok Kanungo advised them to take indigenous food for control of the panic of diabetes. Other Doctors and dignitaries disseminated message on prevention of diabetes among the participants. The symptoms of diabetes was communicated orally and through reading materials, pamphlets and brochures. The publications of CDRF were also distributed among the people of Nayagarh District.

Program on 04.04.2010:

The program on free health check up pertaining to diabetes has also been extended to other districts like Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapara, Puri, Ganjam Districts during this financial year. Such organized camps have been in Jagatsinghpur District in the month of March and April during this month. One camp was conducted at Krishnanandapur, Jagatsinghpur on 04.04.2010 in which 144 patients undergone free treatment and diet counseling. The dignified Doctors and social activists of CDRF and KIDS have rendered health services participants. Blood sugar level testing and counseling services on symptoms of diabetes had been imparted.



Diabetes Awareness programme:

The general symptoms of diabetes are discussed in the awareness program for mass sensitization. The Doctors of the organization disseminate the message on the common symptoms such as fatigue, feeling of thirsty, Irritability, infection and poor wound healing, large amount of water is excreted out of the body, increased hunger etc.: Due to inefficiency of the cell to metabolize glucose, reserve

fat of body is metabolized to gain energy. When fat is broken down in the body, it uses more energy as compared to glucose, hence body goes in negative calorie effect, which results in fatigue. Similarly people were sensitized upon various other things likewise: As the concentration of glucose increases in the blood, brain receives signal for diluting it and, in counteraction we feel thirsty. Increase in urine production is due to excess glucose present in body. Body gets rid of the extra sugar in the blood by excreting it through urine. This leads to dehydration because along with the sugar, a large amount of water is excreted out of the body. The hormone insulin is also responsible for stimulating hunger. In order to cope up with high sugar levels in blood, body produces insulin which leads to increased hunger. Factors like loss of water (polyuria), glucosuria , metabolism of body fat and protein may lead to weight loss. Few cases may show weight gain due increased appetite. Hyperosmolar hyperglycemia nonketotic syndrome is the condition when body fluid is pulled out of tissues including lenses of the eye, which affects its ability to focus, resulting blurry vision. A sign of high blood sugar is detected because of the inefficient glucose supply to the brain and other body organs, which makes us feel tired and uneasy. The body gives few signals whenever there is

fluctuation in blood sugar (due to suppression of immune system) frequent skin infections like fungal or bacterial or UTI (urinary tract infection). High blood sugar resists the flourishing of WBC. (white blood cell) which is responsible for body immune system. When these cells do not function accordingly, wound healing is not at good pace. Secondly, long standing diabetes leads to thickening of blood vessels which affect proper circulation of blood in different body parts. All the symptoms were elaborated among the participants.

Observation of World Diabetes Day:

CUTTACK **DIABETES** RESEARCH FOUNDATION has celebrated World Diabetes Day during this year alike previous years on 14th November. CDRF and KIDS celebrated World Diabetes Day at Jaydev Bhawan, Bhubaneswar on 14th November'2009. A free diabetes health check up camp and diet exhibition have been organized by the organization. About 500 people attended the camp. On this occasion, a public meeting was arranged and Hon'ble Justice B.P. Das presided over the meeting. Hon'ble Minister, Tourism, Mr. Devi Prasad Mishra graced the program and inaugurated the free health check up camp. The participants

were covered under check up of blood sugar level by the renowned Doctors associated with CDRF and KIDS. The effort of the organization has been appreciated at higher level.



CME PROGRAMME FOR DOCTORS:

Continuing Medical Education (CME) Programme for practising doctors:

CUTTACK DIABETES RESEARCH FOUNDATION has been able to conduct

continuing Medical Education(CME) program in association with KIDS for Doctors on 14th November, 2009. Mrs. Anu Garg, IAS, Commissioner-Cum-Secretary to Govt. of Orissa, Health and Family welfare Dept. inaugurated the program. About 150 doctors all over the state attended the programme and shared their views and experiences.

The purpose of the programme was to encourage practising doctors to keep themselves up-to-date on current developments in medical practice so as to maintain a high professional standard for

serving the diabetes patients. Practising doctors are advised to note whether a particular CME activity has been vetted and awarded points and certificates.



CDRF with KIDS have organized another CME program from 15.02.2010 where Prof.& Dr. P. K. Das, Director, Medical Education and Training addressed the doctors who undergone the CME.



<u>Publication of Diabetes News journals</u> <u>for the interest of Diabetes Patients and</u> <u>general public:</u>

CUTTACK DIABETES RESEARCH FOUNDATION has been publishing journals on Diabetes for the welfare of general pubic. The recent publications are "The Diabetes News"- Technical English

Journal, Ajira Dniyare Diabetes- a Non technical Oriya Quarterly, Ekalavya a Diabetes Journal along with literatures are being published in order to educate people on diabetes and have a look on it's repercussions and remedial measures. The Diabetes News has enriched the public and doctors with outstanding information on different aspects of diabetes. The Doctors across the country have revealed wonderful interest on the publication. Even some Doctors and health outfits from our neighboring countries like Bangla Desh, Srilanka and Pakistan have revealed their keen interest on this journal



OUR FUTURE SKETCH:

The organization is dreaming up day and night to establish certain mandate to combat diabetes in our country. Mostly the following steps are to be taken by CDRF in future.

Comprehensive Total Diabetes Care will be offered at the centre at three levels such as Primary, Secondary and Tertiary. (1)So far as primary level is concerned, anyone with diabetic relatives or indeed any one who suspects he may have developed diabetes can undergo a comprehensive screening programme to detect or rule out diabetes.(2)In case of Secondary level, treatment is to be given to all known diabetic patients with the target of preventing the fright of complication of diabetes.

(3)Similarly in case of Tertiary level, if one has already developed diabetic complications, therapy for relief of suffering from any of the diabetes related complications is also available at this centre. The centre will be one of the few of it's kind in Asia to offer such a comprehensive diabetes treatment programme.

SOME MORE HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES:

To realize our vision, we have rendered our unstinted effort to create the most advanced state of the art diabetes care research and education system Bhubaneswar Dumduma. which inaugurated on 14th November,2008 by Shri Naveen Patnaik, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Orissa. This centre has been well equipped to provide diabetes care to all diabetes of Eastern India, training to Diabetes Care givers and education to diabetes patients and general public in a large scale. The institute viz. KIDS which is having a capacity of 100 bedded Super

Specialties Hospital. CDRF is striving hard to render world class treatment measures to the general public right now and hopes to uproot the panic from the minds of innumerable patients of our state.

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
